Note: Photo reference used merely to finesse observation skills and teach a broad language of technique---not as rigid constraint.

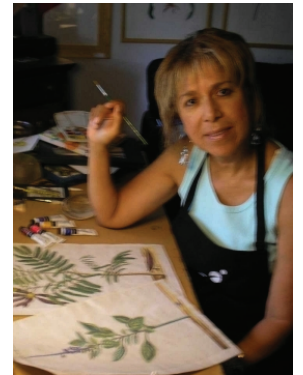
