ENTRIES: Open to all media. Limit 2 pieces. Maximum size 30" x 40".

ENTRY DEADLINE: May 15, 2009.

Work must have been completed within last two years and not previously shown in Summer View. All two dimensional work must be framed and wired ready to hang (no saw tooth hangers, STRING or tabs.) Pieces requiring covering must use plexiglass — NO GLASS. Pieces not meeting these requirements will not be accepted. Three-dimensional work requiring a special pedestal or installation, will be the responsibility of the artist to install.

Although all due precautions will be taken in handling the work, SVAA and Liberty Center Gallery will not be responsible for any loss or damage to art work. The artist agrees to

enter work at their own risk, any insurance is the responsibility of the artist. All work to remain on view until the end of the show.

SALES: A 30% commission will be retained by the Liberty Center Association for the Arts on all work sold during Summer View. Artists are asked to price their work accordingly.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all artists 16 years and older.

 - \$25 non-members for 2 entries
 - \$40 new membership & entry fee for 2 entries*
